

Report on Immunization

As you already know that we could start our immunization clinic on 2nd February 2008 which was a long awaited dream.

From this month it will take place twice a week that is Thursdays and Saturdays instead of only Saturdays. Thursdays will be only for immunization day and Saturdays will be immunization as well as counselling sessions. We have tried our best to inform and motivate all the mothers verbally to come and avail this facility completely free of cost. All these Saturdays a lady who has been appointed for this purpose.

Counselling done:

- Reproductive Health especially its efficacy on Ante Natal Care Services.
- Counselling on condom promotion which plays an important role of dual action.
- Permanent methods for contraception having one child, two children three or more children for both the partners. More motivation given for Non Scalpel Vasectomy (NSV) for the males.
- Emergency contraception pills to avoid unwanted pregnancy.
- Regular use of Oral contraceptive pills for family planning.
- Knowledge on Reproductive Tract Infection / Sexually Tract Infection.
- Awareness was given on childhood diseases
 - Diphtheria
 - Pertusis
 - Tetanus Neonatorum
 - Tetanus Others
 - Acute Flaccid Paralysis
 - Measles
 - Diarrhoea & dehydration
 - ARI
 - Malaria
 - Tuberculosis
